### **Major Description**

The major in Organizational Leadership has been designed for those involved in both for-profit and not-for-profit environments. The skills learned and applied during the program include: leading people to create and achieve a common goal, communicating clearly and professionally, developing and following an ethical decision making model, and thinking creatively to solve problems and make logical decisions in a business environment.

### **Learning Outcomes**

The Organizational Leadership major equips students to:

- Apply theoretical leadership concepts in organizational settings and formulate personal leadership philosophy.
- Develop personal competencies and skills to lead others to create and achieve common goals.
- Apply interpersonal skills to work collaboratively with diverse groups of people to accomplish organizational, team, and individual goals.
- Employ exemplary oral and written communication skills to present a professional image within the context of a variety of business environments.
- Analyze the basic functions of an organization in order to coordinate efforts for organizational success.
- Analyze business problems and situations critically and creatively to execute logical decisions within a business environment.
- Formulate personal ethical perspective and identify Christianbased principles in approaching professional and organizational responsibilities.
